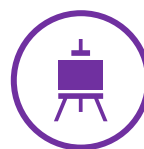

Round 1: PRELIMINARY Round will be conducted on Day 1 (Jan 8, 2022).

Platform: Dare2compete (Link would be shared on the day of the event, participants are requested to familiarise themselves with the platform, only one member would be opening the quiz and they can connect with the other member through phone)



Round 2: FINAL Round on Day 2 (Jan 9, 2022)

Platform: Zoom (Live) (Links would be circulated a few days before the event with the participants qualifying the first round)

The final round would also consist of a buzzer segment, one participant from each team is requested to log on to cag.buzz (advice you to open the buzzer in a separate device).

The code would be shared on the day of the event.
